- *F* The Byzantines were constantly at war with the Celts, who sought to build an Eastern empire for themselves so that they could defeat the Romans. *The Celts lived in western Europe and were at war with the Western Roman Empire. The Byzantines were constantly at war with the Arabs and Turks.*
- *F* Byzantine government was ruled by the common people. *The Byzantine government was ruled by an emperor.*
- <u>*T*</u> The family unit was highly valued by Byzantine society.
- <u>F</u> Byzantine women enjoyed the same social status as Byzantine men. Although they had many responsibilities in the home, Byzantine women had a low social status.
- <u>*T*</u> Religious icons were commonly used in prayer during Byzantine worship.
- *F* The Byzantine Empire finally fell to the Ottoman Turks in A.D. 476. *The Western Roman Empire collapsed in A.D. 476, but the Byzantine Empire continued for a thousand years until it finally fell to the Turks in 1453.*
- <u>*T*</u> The Turks changed the name of Constantinople to Istanbul.
- <u>*T*</u> Justinian built a beautiful cathedral, called the Hagia Sophia, in Constantinople.
