## TRUE OR FALSE?

For each of these questions, write T (for True) or F (for False) in the space provided.  $\underline{T}$  Muslim rulers were called caliphs.

- <u>T</u> Muhammad began to teach the religion of Islam in Arabia around A.D. 610. After his death, his followers spread Islam all over the Mediterranean world.
- *F* Medina (or Medinah) is the holiest city for Muslims. *Mecca is the holiest city for Muslims.*
- <u>*T*</u> The Five Pillars of Islam describe the five basic beliefs of Islam.
- *F* Muhammad never married but remained single so that he could best teach others about Islam. *Muhammad married a widow named Khadijah.*
- <u>*T*</u> Muslims are required to take a pilgrimage, or *Hajj*, to Mecca once in their lifetime.
- <u>*T*</u> During the month-long observance of Ramadan, Muslims fast during the daytime as a way to practice selfcontrol and to remind themselves that all Muslims are equal.
- *F* Muhammad taught that there is one true god, Brahma, to whom each faithful Muslim believer must pray. *Muhammad and all Muslims worship Allah. Hindus worship Brahma.*
- <u>T</u> A mosque is a Muslim place of prayer, like a church, where Muslims pray and hear preaching.
- *F* Muslims use the Bible as their holy book, just like Christians. *The Muslims' holy book is the Qur'an (or Koran).*
