

- Conquered the Lombards and Saxons
- Subdued enemies in Spain
- Expanded his empire to encompass the Netherlands, Belgium, France, and western Germany

- A successful ruler
- Made system of fiefs and vassals to rule his empire
- Relied on Missi Dominici (messengers) to update him on the condition of his realm
- Made many wise laws and appointed judges to ensure laws were carried out

- Promoted schools throughout his realm and invited scholars to educate his own children
- Learned to read and speak Latin (but not to write)
- Promoted the arts
- Instituted libraries
- Flowering of the Carolingian Renaissance, during which scholars developed the form of writing called Carolingian minuscule
