
## ORAL QUIZ ON A MEDIEVAL CASTLE

Have your student identify the parts of the castle on the map on the following page. For each part of the castle, read the description below and ask your student to name and point to the correct part, or have him write the name of the part in the blank provided. The names of the parts may vary, depending on the resource used.

- 1. A ditch, often filled with water, that surrounded the castle (*moat*).
- 2. A heavy wooden platform that could be raised or lowered and was used to cross the moat (*drawbridge*).
- 3. Chambers that guarded the entrance to the castle (*gatehouses*).
- 4. The area between the outer wall and the high inner wall (*outer bailey*).
- 5. The area at the center of a castle, like a courtyard, surrounded by the high inner wall (*inner bailey*).
- 6. The main tower in a castle, to which the people could retreat as a last defense (*keep*).
- 7. Places from which a soldier could watch for possible enemy attacks (*watchtowers*).
- 8. A room reserved for the lord and his lady as their private place (*solar*).
- 9. The biggest room in the castle, used for eating meals and for meetings (great hall).
- 10. A secure place to keep prisoners (*dungeon*).
