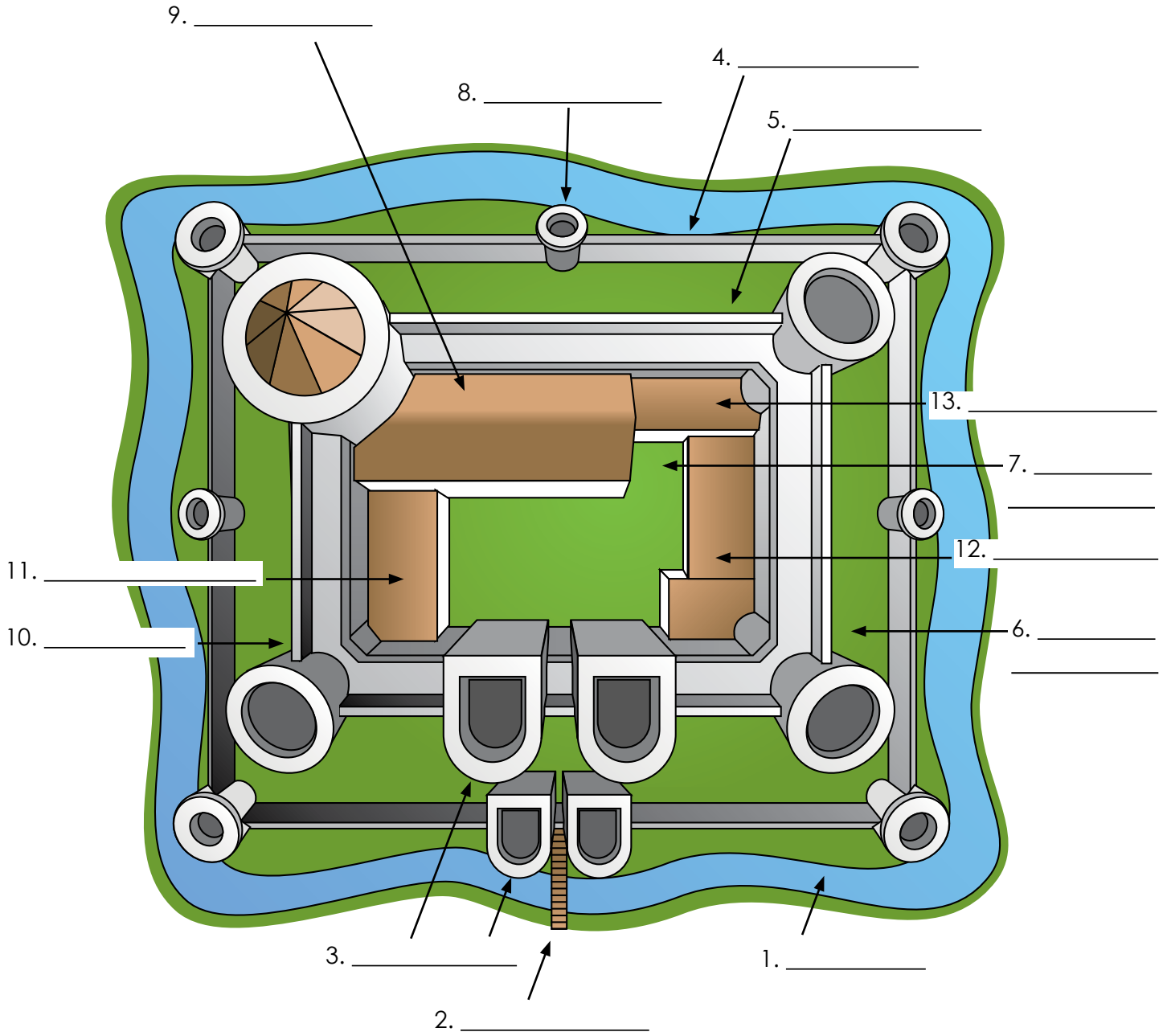


IDENTIFICATION

Each description below refers to a specific part of a castle, shown on the following page. Write the correct name for each part of the castle in the numbered blank provided on the castle map.

1. A ditch, often filled with water, that surrounded the castle
2. A heavy wooden platform that could be raised or lowered and was used to cross the ditch
3. Chambers that guarded the entrance to the castle
4. The outermost wall of the castle
5. The high inner wall of the castle
6. The area between the outer wall and the high inner wall
7. The area at the center of a castle, like a courtyard, surrounded by the high inner wall
8. Rounded towers that enabled soldiers to watch all the sides of a castle
9. The biggest room in the castle, used for eating meals and for meetings
10. A secure place to keep prisoners
11. Housed the lord, the steward, and their families
12. Housed the garrisons
13. Place for food preparation and storage
