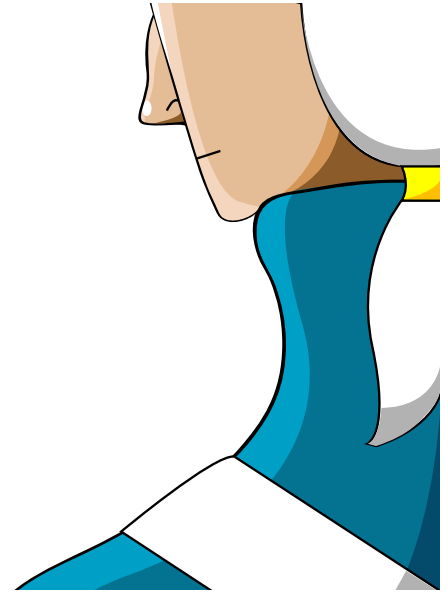


Draw lines from the military leaders listed on the left to their descriptions on the right.

DESCRIPTIONS

Francis Marion

Appointed quartermaster general at Valley Forge by Washington; instrumental in bringing much needed supplies to the battle-worn soldiers at Valley Forge.

Lord Charles Cornwallis

A French nobleman and soldier who believed in America's cause for independence; joined Washington's staff as an unpaid general.

George Washington

Commander of British forces in the southern states who suffered a crushing defeat in the last major battle of the war, known as the Battle of Yorktown.

Baron Friedrich von Steuben

A commander in the Continental Army, also known as the "Swamp Fox" because he would cleverly lead his men to attack British supply lines and then retreat into nearby swamps.

Nathaniel Greene

Commander-in-chief of the Continental Army

Marquis de Lafayette

A Prussian soldier who aided George Washington by transforming the tired, weak, and inexperienced troops at Valley Forge into a disciplined and well-trained fighting force.
