

#### ORAL QUIZ ON BENJAMIN FRANKLIN

This quiz is based on *Benjamin Franklin, A Man of Many Talents*. The points and level of detail given below are those that an upper-grammar student might be expected to know from his reading, though he may not include every detail. You may also use these points to prompt your student.

#### The Life of Benjamin Franklin

- 1. When and where was Benjamin Franklin born? On January 17, 1706, Benjamin was born in Boston, Massachusetts.
- 2. How many brothers and sisters did Benjamin Franklin have? *Benjamin had seventeen siblings!*
- 3. What trade did he learn from his brother? Benjamin became a printer's apprentice to his brother James.
- 4. When he was older and living in Philadelphia, Benjamin wrote a book called *Poor Richard's Almanac*. What kind of book was it? Poor Richard's Almanac was a book in which Benjamin wrote jokes, riddles, and observations about the weather and the stars.
- 5. How did Benjamin prove that lightning is electricity?


On a windy, stormy day in June of 1752, Benjamin and his son decided to fly a kite with an experiment in mind. He placed a metal wire at the top of the kite and then attached a key to the end of the string which he held. A lightning bolt flashed, hit the wire and traveled down the string to the key, giving Benjamin a shock. With this experiment he had proved that lightning was electricity.


- 6. What was the name of the newspaper that Benjamin started in his printing shop? *Benjamin wrote and printed the* Pennsylvania Gazette.
- 7. Name one accomplishment Benjamin achieved while living in Philadelphia. Any of the following are acceptable and you might have different ones as well: He started a library, the first fire department, a college, the first public hospital. He helped govern the colony as a member of the Pennsylvania Assembly and became the first postmaster in the colonies. He invented many things, such as the Franklin stove, bifocals, the odometer, and a musical instrument called an armonica.
- On July 4, 1776, what famous document did Benjamin and other lawmakers sign in order to declare the American colonies free and independent? In 1776, Benjamin signed the Declaration of Independence.
- 9. What is the name of another famous document that Benjamin helped to create? *In 1787, Benjamin joined the Constitutional Convention and helped write the Constitution.*
- 10. When did Benjamin Franklin die and how old was he? Benjamin Franklin died on April 17, 1790, at the age of eighty-four.
