## ORAL QUIZ ON THE BOSTON TEA PARTY


The points and level of detail given below are those which a lower-grammar student might be expected to know from his reading, though he may not include every detail. You may also use these points to prompt your student.

## The Boston Tea Party

- 1. What did laws like the Sugar Act and Stamp Act force the colonists to do?

  The colonists were required to pay taxes on items coming from overseas places like England and other foreign countries.
- 2. Were the colonists happy or upset by these laws? *The colonists were upset because they thought these laws were unfair.*
- 3. What was the Boston Tea Party?

  Late one night, some of the colonists protested the unfair tea tax by dressing up as Indians and throwing chests of tea into Boston Harbor.
- 4. What did the English Parliament do about the Boston Tea Party? Parliament passed very strict laws in hopes that the colonists would submit to the king of England, George III.
- 5. What did the American colonies eventually do as a result of their disagreement with England? *The American colonies fought in a war for independence from England.*
