Plantation A large, self-sufficient farming estate for growing tobacco prevalent in the southern colonies

Squanto The Native American who befriended the Pilgrims and helped them survive at Plymouth

Artisans Craftspeople of the colonial era with a variety of skills such as shoe-making, cabinetmaking, and papermaking

Mayflower Compact A document of governing laws for the people of the Plymouth settlement

Roger Williams A Quaker leader who desired for his fellow Quakers to practice their ideas and faith in peace; established the colony of Pennsylvania.

John Smith Able leader whose hunting and trading skills helped the Jamestown settlement to survive

Quakers A Puritan minister who founded Providence, the capital of the colony of Rhode Island

Triangular Trade A name referring to trade between three ports: Europe, Africa, and the West Indies. Along the trading route, abducted Africans were exchanged for cargo and then sold as slaves.

Separatists A group of people who disagreed with the rules of the Church of England and separated themselves in order to worship and follow God according to the Bible

Samuel de Champlain A courageous and determined French explorer who searched for new trade routes and fur trading settlements; considered the "Father of New France"

Peter Stuyvesant The Dutch governor of the New Netherland colony; also known as "Old Silvernails"

Longhouses Long, wooden-framed dwellings in which family groups of the Iroquois lived

William Penn A young Powhatan princess instrumental in helping the Jamestown colony; later married a colonist and became a Christian

Pocahontas A young Powhatan princess instrumental in helping the Jamestown colony; later married a colonist and became a Christian

Iroquois Confederacy Originally a group of five Iroquois Indian nations (the Seneca, Cayuga, Onondaga, Oneida, and Mohawk tribes, later joined by the Tuscarora tribe) that together formed a government to provide strength, protection, and peaceful relations with one another
